For visitors with mobility impairments:

- all exhibition areas in the museum are accessible by elevator.
- wheelchairs and folding chairs are available at the museum reception desk upon request
- visitors with reduced mobility can access the museum via the entrance at the back of the building at 18 rue Roux-Alphéran





For hard of hearing and deaf visitors: all guided tours are supported by headsets equipped with a magnetic induction loop system (T-coil function).



The musée Granet offers specially designed guided tours with partner organisations:

- tactile learning.
- sensory tours.



For visitors who are blind or have low vision:

- tactile interpretations of the selected artworks, created and sponsored by EssilorLuxottica Workshops, are available in the Early and Classic Painting Gallery (the ground floor) and the Cezanne room (first floor)
- all tactile devices are accompanied by Braille and audio descriptions

- guided tours tailored to adults or children.
- painting, drawing or sculpture workshops.
- educational tools inspired by the museum's art collections.
