For visitors with mobility impairments:

- all the museum's exhibition areas are accessible by elevators.
- wheelchairs and folding chairs are available at the museum reception desk upon request.
- persons with reduced mobility can access the museum at the rear of the building, 18 rue Roux-Alphéran.







For hearing-impaired and deaf visitors: all guided-tours are facilitated by the use of headsets equipped with a magnetic induction-loop system (T function).








The musée Granet offers special guided tours with partner organizations:
